LOT SALES & FEE SCHEDULE

Elm Grove Cemetery/Bright Cemetery

Deed Transfers - \$50.00 (contact Fiscal Officer)

Owner Sale/Transfer – Seller pays the \$50 deed transfer fee, Buyer pays \$100 recording fee

Payments (All checks must be made payable to **Marion Township Trustees**)

Digging & Foundations

The Marion Township Trustees will designate a contractor for **all** digging and foundation work. Depth and width of footers to be in accordance with the Township specification rules.

RULES & REGULATIONS TO BE OBSERVED BY LOT OWNERS & VISITORS

- Cemetery hours are Dawn to Dusk.
- All graves are to be cleaned up by April 1st and again by October 1st of each year by the Cemetery Sexton.
- All persons are forbidden to remove the flags from graves or disturb any objects on grave sites, other than their own.
- Persons setting up gravestones or monuments must notify the Cemetery Sexton or Trustees 48 hours prior to doing so, to ensure verification of location.
- All wreaths and artificial flowers are to be secured, and no glass containers are allowed. Ornamental loose stones or flowers **MUST** be placed/planted within surrounding lawn edging. Additional shrubs are prohibited – existing shrubs are to be trimmed to monument height.
- No above ground mausoleums permitted to accommodate full body.
- **POSITIVELY** no dog walking and no pets are permitted in the cemeteries.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO UNAUTHORIZED DIGGING.**
