MARION TOWNSHIP POLICY REPLACEMENT/REPAIRS OF DAMAGED/DESTROYED MAIL BOX / POST

Whereas the Marion Township Trustees acknowledge there are circumstances during snow removal that it is unavoidable for snow plow trucks/drivers to damage or destroy a mail box or post, or in some cases, both.


Therefore the Trustees desire to establish a Replacement/Repair Policy for the reimbursement or payment of the damages sustained to township mail box/post.

Marion Township residents shall purchase a replacement post and/or mail box, as per the minimum specifications of the U.S. Postal Service. Residents shall submit the *original* invoice/receipt of materials purchased, to the Fiscal Officer for review and reimbursement payment approved by the Trustees shall be for materials only, not to exceed \$125.00 total. Costs for labor will not be considered for reimbursement.


Township will reimburse \$125.00 maximum payment for custom designed, or novelty mail box/post which can be applied towards purchase of replacement/repairs. Costs exceeding \$125.00 shall be borne by the resident.




